You already know that stories can be written in first, second, and third person. Let's dive in a bit deeper and see if we can identify point of view in a few stories.

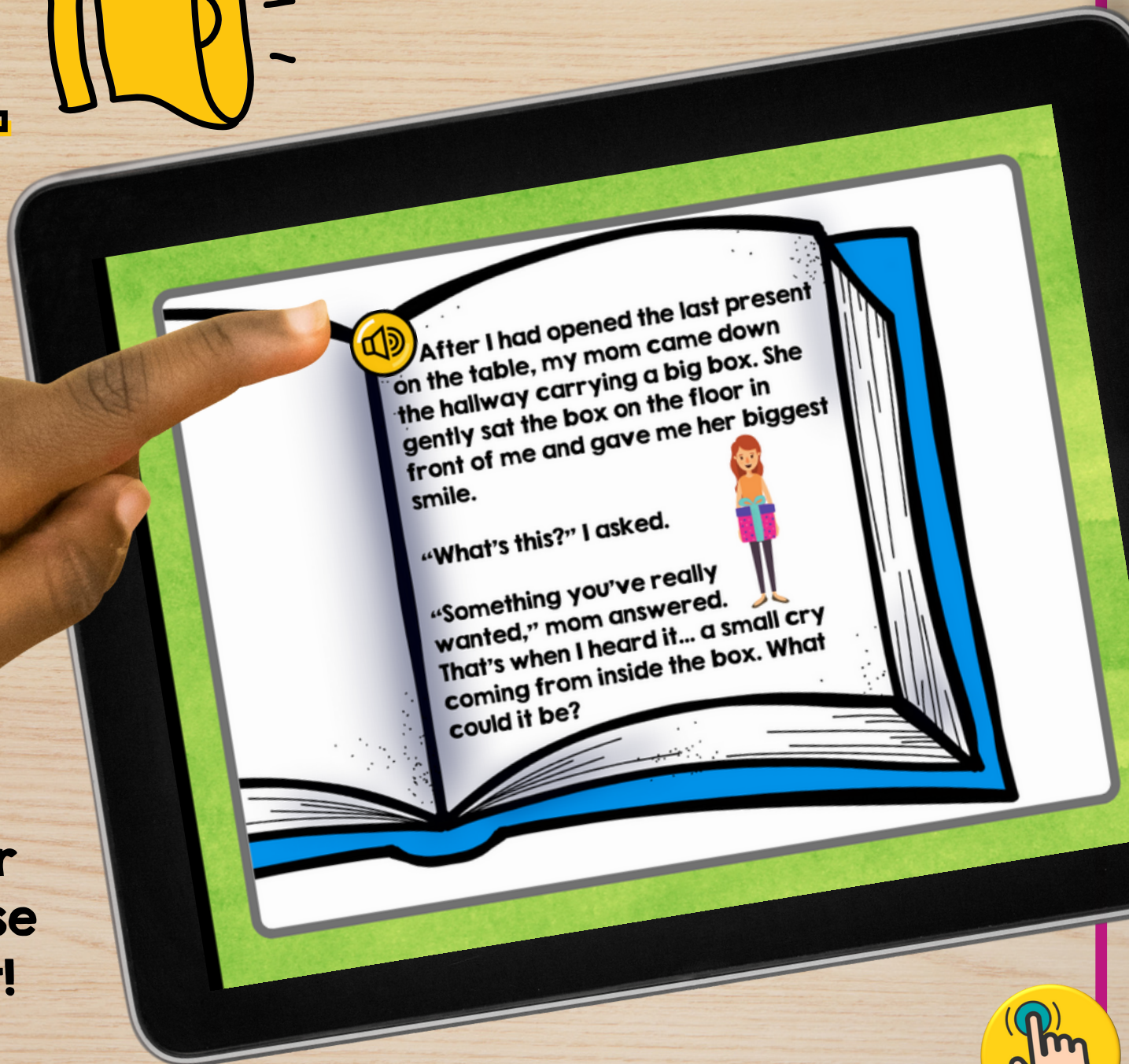
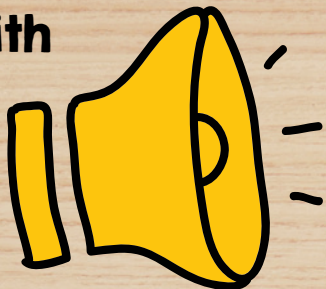
