THE TRAINING

COMPOUND WORDS
Compound words are created when two or more words combine to form a new word or phrase.

Closed Compound Words:
This type of compound word is written as a single word without spaces or hyphens.
dog + house = doghouse

Open Compound Words:
This type is written as two words that are read together in order to form a new meaning.
ice + cream = ice cream

Hyphenated Compound Words:
This type is two or more smaller words joined together by a little line called a hyphen.
runner + up = runner-up

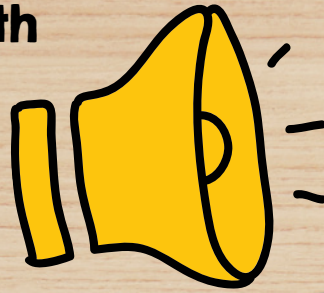
