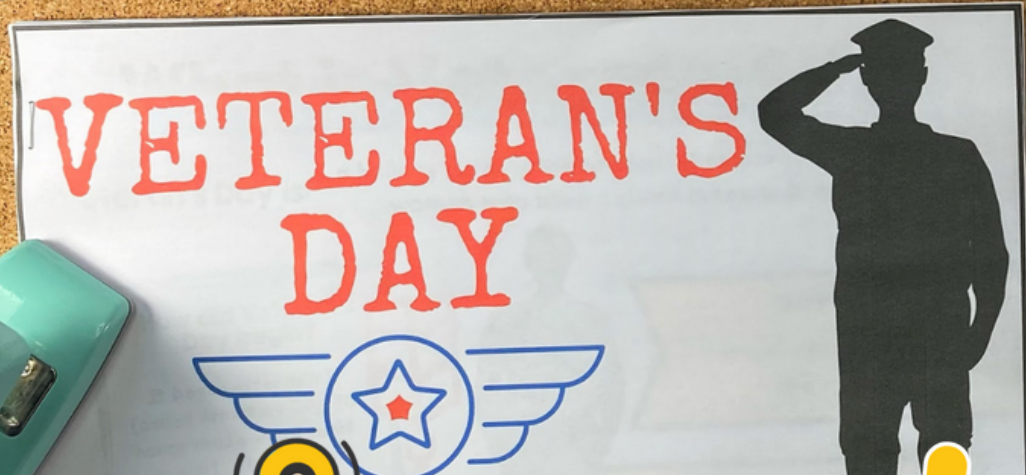
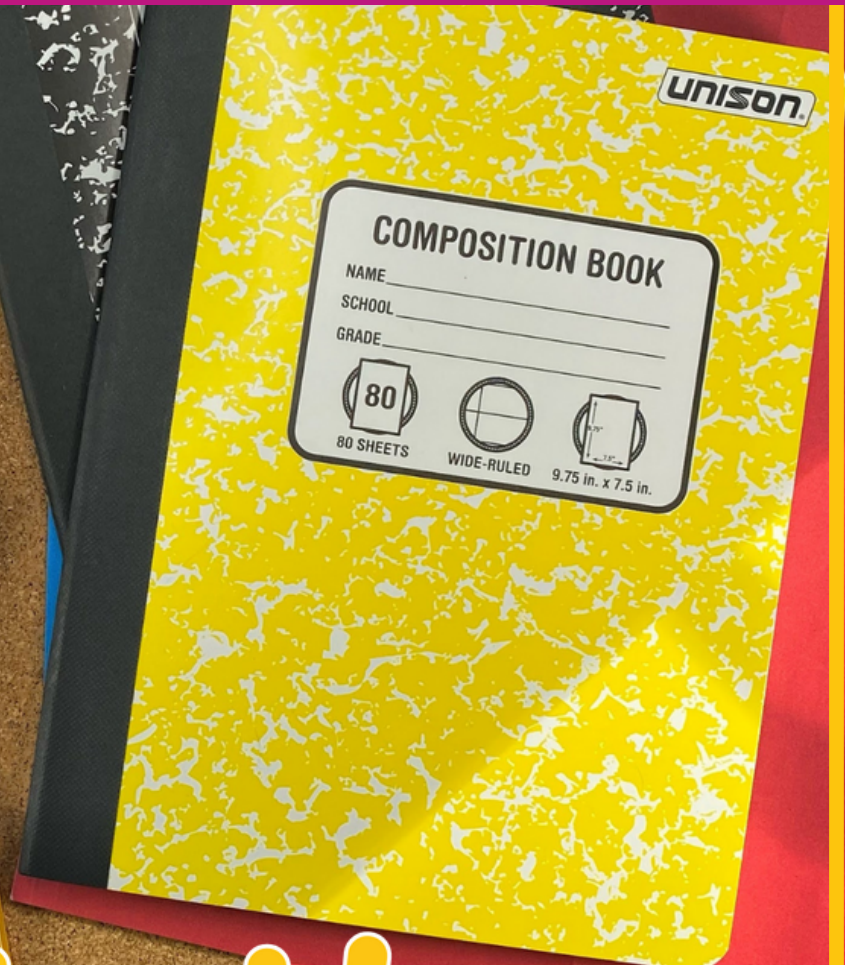

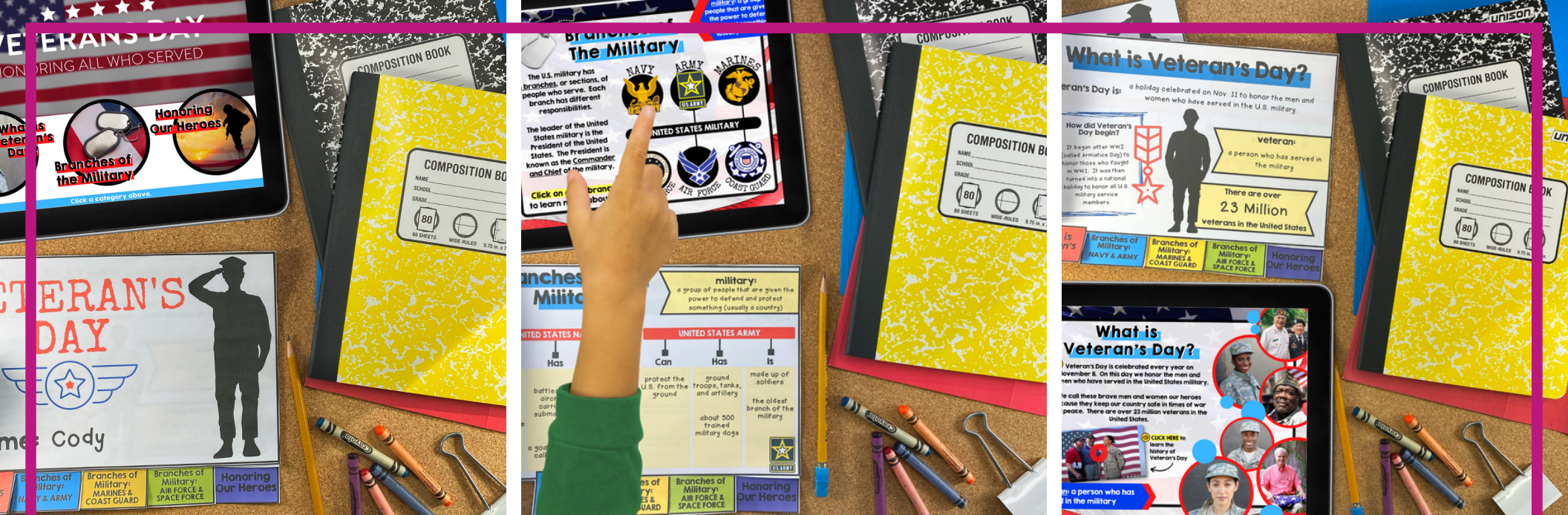

DID YOU KNOW?

The U.S. Marine Corps was originally formed to fight aboard warships. However, they now defend the U.S. on land, at sea, and in the air. To become a Marine is very challenging. Marines go through 13 weeks of intense training, the longest training of any of the 6 military branches. Once fully trained, Marines participate in a variety of responsibilities including transporting military supplies around the world, protecting naval bases, and being prepared to defend at any moment.

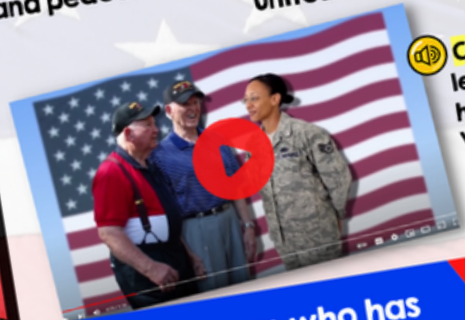


What is Veteran's Day?
