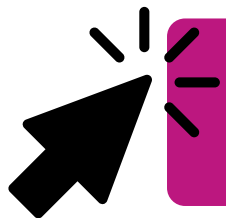

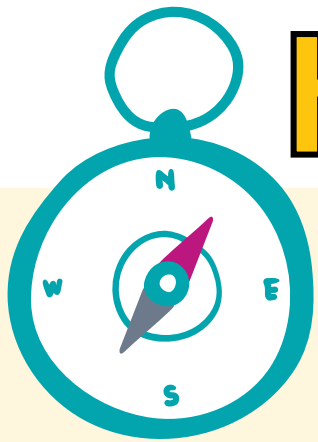

**SNAP A PICTURE**

The **Great Barrier Reef**, off the coast of Australia, is made up of about 3,000 separate reefs and surrounds over 900 islands. It is so large that the reefs are the only living structure visible from space!

The reefs are home to a wide-variety of plants and animals

Harbor of Rio de Janeiro in Brazil is breathtaking! It is surrounded by granite mountains and gorgeous coastlines. It is world-famous for being the world's largest bay.

A huge 98 foot (30 meters) tall statue called "Christ the Redeemer" overlooks the harbor.

**SNAP A PICTURE**

Why is Everest so tall? Click the video to find out!

Towering at over 29,000 feet (over 8,800 m) above sea level stands **Mount Everest** in Asia. Many people from around the world train to be able to climb this massive mountain, but only about 5,000 people have actually been able to do so!

**SNAP A PICTURE**

Paricutin erupting in 1943 at night

Farmers grow many things in their fields, but no one expected one farmer in Mexico to grow a volcano! However, that's exactly what happened in 1943. Overnight, the **Paricutin Volcano** erupted from the ground, growing over 400 feet (125 m) in just one day! By the end of the third day, it was over 1,000 feet (over 330m)!

The volcano continued to erupt for 9 years until it finally stopped in 1952. As a result of the now over 9,000 foot volcano (over 2,000 m), two villages and hundreds of homes had been destroyed.
